



Prior to 1970 Zwicker was an award-winning newspaper writer for the Globe and Mail, Toronto Star and The Detroit News, among others. His commentary "Facing the Fourth Estate" was aired weekly on 18 CBC stations. He taught journalism for seven years at Ryerson University and worked for 15 years at Vision TV, finishing with his own weekly program, "Media File." In March 2002 he produced the 44-minute video The Great Deception and in the Fall of 2004 the DVD The Great Conspiracy: The 9/11 News Special You Never Saw. He is currently working on a book about false flag operations in history.
